



HOW DO I CHECK-IN MY CHILDREN?

Each Sunday, during all the adult worship services, Parkway Fellowship's exciting Kids & Student Ministries provide worship and Bible study environments which are constructed to teach your children where they are developmentally. The adult worship service is designed for adults, so we encourage parents to allow their children to attend a service in their age-appropriate setting.

PRESCHOOL & KIDS (up to 5th grade)

Your first check-in for preschool and elementary age children requires a little bit of time. Your child's safety is of paramount importance, so we check each child in and assign matching tags for you and your child. Your child cannot be picked up without the tag you carry, so their safety is assured.

To get them checked in for the first time, we encourage you to come to Guest Services in the main lobby. Your concierge will assist you getting them checked into the system, print your security tags, and then walk with you to your child's classroom. Or, you may go directly to the Preschool area and a Kids Ministry volunteer will check-in your child (up to 5th grade).

After the worship service, you may pick up your child by returning to the room and giving your matching tag to the volunteer.

STUDENTS (6th grade & up)

Parents are not required to check students in at the Gym, however, they are always welcome to come check it out. All a student needs to do is come to the Gym and approach the First Time Guest table, which is conveniently located by the door.

Student services generally consist of time to socialize with friends, worship, a lesson from the Bible, and guided discussion with a Student Ministry staff member or volunteer. When it's done, students are released to come to you – or you can meet them at the Gym.
